Rules of Migration of students from College to another College notified Vide No.3093-3122 Dated 02-07-1985

1. These rules shall be called the Islamia University of Bahawalpur (Inter Collegiate Migration) Rules of 1984 and shall come into force at once.
2. No student who has joined a college shall be admitted to another college during the same course unless migration is allowed under these Rules.
3. Migration of a student admitted in a college to another college may be allowed on any of the following grounds namely.
 - a. If a change of residence by his father or guardian, as the case may be, has made it necessary for the student to change his college;
 - b. If the student wishes to take up a subject which is not taught in the college;
 - c. If change in financial circumstances has made it necessary, for the student to change his college.

 - (i) The student desiring to migrate to another college shall submit an application, mentioning all the relevant facts and duly supported by the documents, to the Principal.
 - (ii) The student shall have to obtain the recommendation of the Principal of the college where he wants to migrate.
 - (iii) The Principal, shall forward the application with his recommendation to the Vice Chancellor for permission.
 - (iv) The Principal, after obtaining the permission of the Vice-Chancellor, may issue the college leaving certificate and shall mention therein the percentage of lectures attended by the student, the amount of fee and dues paid by the student and his observation about the character and conduct of the student.
5. A student may compulsorily be migrated to another college if the college discipline so requires and the principals of colleges concerned agree.
6. If a student's name is struck off the rolls of a college, such student may be re-admitted at any time during the same academic year to the same class in the college from which his name was struck off. Such a student may, at the commencement of the next academic years, be admitted to the same class in any other college on production of a leaving certificate from the College he last attended but not later than the date prescribed for late admission, provided it does not involve any infringement of the rules laid down (a) defining one academic year preceding the examination; and (b) regarding rustication and expulsion of students.

Rules of Migration of students from another University to the Islamia University of Bahawalpur and IUB Campus to Campus.

1. Candidate must fulfill the conditions of admission into Islamia University, provided that he has a comparable ranking on merit fixed by the University for that year.
2. Candidate must have sound reason for migration with certificate of good conduct.
3. Syllabi and contents of courses of subject concerned in the University of the Candidate must conform to those of Islamia University.
4. Migration shall be allowed subject to availability of seats in the department concerned.
5. Candidate must have attended at least 75% of his classes (Lectures and practical) in his department/university.
7. Candidate must provide details of the courses and practical that he had completed in his university.
8. Candidate shall submit certificates from the Chairman/Head of the Institution or Principal of college concerned in regard to items 5, 6 and 7.
9. Candidate shall complete conditions of compulsory courses in Islamia University after migration.
10. In case of migration, the candidate shall pay all fees and dues to the Islamia University for the whole session.
11. The Vice-Chancellor shall allow migration of candidate on the recommendation of the Chairman & Dean concerned.
