Islamia University Bahawalpur Regularized 544 Contract Employees

Islamia University Bahawalpur regularized 544 contract employees from grade 1 to 18. These employees have been made permanent under the Punjab Regularization Act 2018. for resolving this long pending issue. Employees said that the way Engr. Talking to radio Pakistan he said that after the completion of mega projects it will be a leading University which will cater the educational need of the remote areas of South Punjab as

production, pest/insect control and degradation of pollutants. During this three-day workshop participants were provided with




